



Within the framework of the exercise of pedagogical guardianship over institutions of higher training affiliated to other ministerial departments in accordance with the provisions of Executive Decree No. 18-263 of October 17, 2018, which defines the conditions for granting pedagogical guardianship and the modalities of its exercise, the Sub-Directorate carried out the following operations:

This evaluation allowed to:

- 1. identify some of the imbalances regarding the training offers that, despite their qualification, have not been activated.
- 2.- **Withdrawing the accreditation**, granted by the Ministry of Higher Education, from the Institute of Electronics and Mechanics in Algiers, and the redistribution of enrolled students.
- 3.-Supervising the status of the Institute of Mining and Development, and take precautionary measures pending a decision by the competent authorities.
- 4. After the positive evaluation of some institutions, they were authorized to guarantee the training in the second phase of the master.
- 5.-Preparing Modules that set out the specific data and specifications of final certificates for some private higher training institutions in coordination with the Directorate of Certificates and Equivalencies.
- 6.- Preparing legal texts related to competences, formation and functioning of the committee charged for the study of applications of institutions establishment of higher training.
- 7.-**Preparing a digital platform** for filing applications for private institutions establishment of higher training, and allowing their owners to supervise their files.
- 8. **Studying five requests for private institutions** establishment of higher training.





University project

the Algerian Open University is expected to give an opportunity that allows the largest number of people to enter the university, and the economic and social sector to cover an important aspect of its needs in the formation and improvement of the level of its human resources.

The new Algerian Open University project will work on responding in a flexible and adaptive way to the need for developing the potential and skills of individuals, over the life course, in service of their personal and professional aspirations.

In this context, the adoption of the distance education model is considered as a new mechanism to accommodate the increasing demands of affiliation to universities, which is a complementary contribution to the higher education system in Algeria.

This educational style also keeps space with the changes that affected the different ways of teaching, using modern information and communication technologies. Hence, distance education, using digital structures (digital platforms, data centers, virtual libraries, audio-visual materials) represents an appropriate solution to respond to the challenges arising from the development of student numbers and the need to improve human resources skills regardless of their qualification level, without the need To increase in a steady and expensive way of the construction pace of new reception structures.

The tasks entrusted to the Algerian Open University fall within the framework of the sector recommendations, which aim to:

- Strengthening distance education within the national system of higher education and spreading it.
- Developing trainings that will be graduated with certificates and qualifications according to the patterns adapted to distance education and lifelong training.
- pedagogical contents Production and spreading based on digital and virtual technologies.
- Providing information resources, props and applications for the development of distance education.
- Responding to the increasing demand of the various segments of society of higher education, through flexible and adapted formations.
- Providing knowledge and technologies related to distance education for the benefit of the various actors in the sector, including professors, students, managers and technicians.
- Giving a return to all possibilities of technological transformation within the framework of the international cooperation of the sector, with the aim of ensuring permanent rehabilitation.
- Practicing expert activities, upon request, consulting and providing services to universities, high schools as well as bodies and major institutions that have training programs.



A national workshop was organized to promote research in the social and human sciences on November 22 and 23, 2021, and it addressed the following broad lines:

University Openness to the social and economic environment

In light of strengthening the partnership between the higher education sector and scientific research with the various ministerial sectors and sectors of activity, in order to expand the university's openness to its economic and social environment, a number of agreements were signed:



The signing of a partnership agreement on September 08, 2021 between the Industrial Technology Research Center and the National Corporation for the Production of Railway Equipment and Supplies, in the presence of the Minister of Higher Education and Scientific Research, Professor Dr. Abdulbaki benzine and the Ministers of Industry and Transport. The agreement included the completion of a project to make a gravel collecting machine for reclamation Farmland





1655 new financial positions were created for university institutions in order to hire "B" assistant professors, and more than 400 new financial positions were created to hire "B" university hospital assistant professors, as a result of the signing of a partnership agreement between the Ministry of Higher Education and Scientific Research and the Ministry of Labor, Employment and Social Security on 15 September 2021, this ministerial instruction sets new mechanisms and measures to expand the employment outlets for PhD holders, forming a strong impetus for their employment and integration into the labor market.





In order to consolidate the efforts of the higher education and scientific research sector to intensify research in the field of energy security, a set of agreements was signed on October 10, 2021 between a group of central universities and research centers, through a workshop on partnership between the institution and the university organized by the Research and Development Center of Sonatrach, in which the Minister of Higher Education and Scientific Research participated, accompanied by the Minister of Energy and Mines and the governor of Boumerdes





Signing an agreement with the Minister of Water Resources and Water Security on November 14, 2021, and the major axes of this cooperation can be sought in accompanying the Ministry of Higher Education and Scientific Research for this strategic sector through master's and doctoral training, as well as enabling students to conduct field training





Preparing the students of the Higher School of Mathematics and the Higher School of Artificial Intelligence for professions related to the hydrocarbon sector and renewable energies, a partnership agreement was signed between the Ministry of Higher Education and Scientific Research and the National Company for Research, Production, Transportation and Marketing of Hydrocarbons to Sonatrach

On November 24, 2021, in addition to opening the way for students for field training and facilitating their integration into the labor market.





Prof. Dr. Abdelbagi Benziane supervised the signing ceremony of a partnership and cooperation agreement in higher training, research and development between Oran University of Science and Technology Mohamed Boudiaf and the Satellite Development Center on December 11, 2021. This agreement allows monitoring of doctoral training and joint preparation of projects as well as the exchange of experiences and development search and configuration





The General Directorate of Scientific Research and Technological Development concluded a partnership agreement with the National Corporation for Electronic Industries on December 14, 2021. This agreement culminated in the establishment of a Department for Scientific Research and Technological Development and the appointment of a head in the National Corporation for Electronic Industries.



On the sidelines of the visit of the Minister of Higher Education and Scientific Research to the Daouia farm, where the students of agricultural sciences at the University of Hama Lakhdar receive field and practical training, an agreement was signed between the University of the Martyr Hama Lakhdar and farm of al-Daouia, and another agreement with lactobacillus of el oued on January 11, 2022. Both agreements aim to: He made applied agricultural research at the service of the national economy, and Prof. Dr. "Abdulbaki benziane" inspected a model farm for experiments on sugar beetroot, which is a joint project between the University of Martyr Hama Lakhdar, farm of Al-Daouia and the agricultural interests of the state of El-oued.






In an effort to strengthen the partnership between research institutions and structures in the sectors of the Ministry of Higher Education and Scientific Research and the Ministry of Fisheries and Fisheries Products, a set of agreements was signed between the two sectors on February 06, 2022.

Ministerial activities related to expanding the university's openness to its economic and social environment













On Monday, September 06th, 2021, the Minister of Higher Education and Scientific Research participated in the closing of the seventh edition activities of the program:

"Seeds for the Future of Algeria 2021", is a training program under the supervision of the global company Huawei for Information and Communications Technology, with the support of the Minister of Digitization and Statistics, the Minister of Post and Telecommunications, the Minister Delegate to the Prime Minister in charge of the Knowledge Economy and Emerging Enterprises, and the General Manager of Huawei in Algeria. This event is the culmination of the partnership established by the sector with the international Chinese company Huawei, and included in the memorandum of understanding signed in 2018.

In order to enhance the role of the economic sector institutions, on September 9th, Prof. Dr. Abdelbaki BENZIANE, accompanied by the Minister of Labour, Employment and Social Security and the Minister of Tourism, participated in the closing works of the "Algeria Horizons". A program to support training and employment, and funded by Algeria and the European Union. In this forum, the problem of school dropout, professional integration, and management responsibilities in administrative training centers were highlighted

After the presentation of the Malaysian experience in the field of Islamic banking on October 25th, the Minister listened to the request of a researcher, in the Department of Islamic Law and Islamic legal politics at the University of Malaysia, to train managers in this field by opening universities and institutes for the development of Islamic banking. The head of division of Islamic banking in the International Academy of Islamic legal politics of Malaysia paid tribute to the efforts of Algerian scholars to develop financial transactions in accordance with this type of governance in financial affairs.

On the opening ceremony of the new academic year in the training institutions of the Ministry of Tourism held on November 4, 2021, the Minister of Higher Education and Scientific Research stated the desire of his sector to activate cooperation strategies in order to improve and develop the quality of research and training in the field of tourism in Algeria, as it constitutes a key source not only for the Algerian economy, but also for the economies of most countries of the world.

On the opening of the new university year at the Great School of Sports Sciences and Technologies on November 09, 2021 Prof. Dr. Abdelbaki BENZIANE stressed the importance of continuing work and coordination with the youth and sports sector. It is an embodiment of the strategy of the higher education and scientific research sector aimed at reviving sports in the university community and enriching training offers and their contents with the supervision of experts, professors, researchers and specialists from the sector.

In the meeting of Prof. Dr. Abdelbaki BENZIANE with the Minister of National Education on December 02, in order to discuss ways of coordination and strengthening the relationship between the two sectors, several files were studied along the lines of preparing for a draft agreement regulating the training procedures for students affiliated with Great Schools for teachers, at the level of educational institutions affiliated with the Ministry of National Education















On December 09th, 2021, Prof. Dr. Abdelbaki BENZIANE attended the School Day organized by the Ministry of Youth and Sports in cooperation with the National Authority for the Prevention and Fight against Corruption. The slogan of the day was: "Strengthening Integrity in Youth and Sports."

On the opening of the second edition of the National Exhibition for Innovation on December 21, 2021, the Minister of Higher Education and Scientific Research revealed that his sector has prepared a regulatory framework that allows encouraging and accompanying young project holders in the field of innovation in various disciplines that respond to the requirements of the economic sector

Prof. Dr. Abdelbaki BENZIANE, accompanied by the Minister Delegate to the Prime Minister in charge of Emerging Enterprises and the Minister of Fisheries and Fisheries Products, supervised on March 08th 2022 the activities of organizing the national competition for the best micro-feminine economic activity. An event that highlighted the great role that women play in promoting national production and achieving comprehensive and sustainable development



Scholarships and foreign students

Algeria receives annually, within the framework of the government's program for scholarships and bilateral cooperation programs with Arab countries, approximately 2,700 foreign students to study in Algerian universities, and the total number of foreign students studying in Algerian universities is currently estimated at 7,200,

539 of them enrolled during the 2022/2021 university season



Taking care of students granted in China who were stuck in Algeria and were unable to continue their academic studies in Chinese universities due to the pandemic, (about 89 students) by integrating a group of them into Algerian university institutions, provided that the rest of the students continue to study remotely

Developing a digital platform to count and follow up on Algerian students returning from Ukraine, and allocate two in charge to follow up the process where 162 students were counted, and work is currently underway to find the most appropriate solutions to take care of them, whether by integrating them in Algerian universities within the limits of the regulation in force in the field of quidance according to the baccalaureate rate, and specialization or Accompany them to enroll in foreign universities in coordination with the Ministry of Foreign Affairs



Renewaling of scholarships for Algerian students abroad, as the Directorate of University Cooperation and Exchange, during the months of July and August 2021, renewed 837 student scholarships distributed over 25 countries







Upgrading and modernizing university governance mechanisms

In order to introduce the rights and duties of members of the university family, a digital portal has been established on the ministry's website, carrying all the necessary documents

in addition to a charter of ethics for the university profession with the Minister being the first to sign it electronically on October 7, 2021 during the national symposium for universities, giving a signal to all members of the university family to sign the charter.

The legal formula has also been given to the local committees of the council in order to install them at the level of all university institutions across the country to take care of addressing the problems of the university family such as the spread of the phenomenon of plagiarism.

To promote a culture of university ethics, the council suggested:

Awareness days for ethics and morals in the field for the whole university family.

Preparing a news bulletin under the supervision of the Council and organizing media sessions on its social networks.

Proposing a draft memorandum to combat cheating in the university environment.

Sending a letter to all higher education institutions inviting local committees to present the outcome of their activities via a digital platform, so that regional meetings will be organized later by these committees.

Upgrading and modernizing university governance mechanisms

As a prospect for the sector, the Council seeks to consolidate a culture of ethics through:



Reduce the number of complaints that come to the ministry by treating them at the academic committees of higher education institutions on a consensual basis.



Preparing a questionnaire to try to solve all the problems of the university family with the help of quality and governance bodies The work carried out by the National Council for Ethics and the Ethics of the University Profession is an embodiment of the political project aimed at promoting higher education institutions, addressing the problems of the sector and limiting behaviors that are not appropriate for the university institution.

- Subsuming 54 higher training institutions affiliated to other ministerial departments and 17 institutions especially for higher training in the regional universities seminars as a space of exchanging views and well practices for the benefit of these institutions.
- Allowing the doctorate student to engage technically and effectively in the process of research and knowledge production, where he will be graduated with the highest diploma in his academic path.
- Defining the horizons and setting goals that allow confronting the most important challenges that training faces, through the obligation of responding the economic and social sectors.
- training Innovation as well as providing competent persons to build a society of knowledge.
- Preparing the necessary mechanisms that allow achieving the desired horizons.

- Promoting the applied research and boosting the establishment, integration and employment of Doctorate students in the professional community.
- Putting into service doctoral schools that devote the principle of cooperation and partnership between social institutions that aim to achieve common goals through:



Facilitating mobility of the Doctorate students to benefit within the framework of national mobility and take advantage of opportunities to conduct experiments and exploit technological grounds at the level of university institutions throughout the country.

creating an appropriate atmosphere in order to realize the doctoral thesis in a professional environment (Doctorate in the institution)



- Re-drafting the "Canevas" form, a new file that holds all the special documents, of records and identification papers, presenting the correctness and integrity of the conduct of elections of scientific bodies at university institutions, and the legitimacy of the nominated professors in terms of ranks, to bring it in line with the executive decree that defines the tasks of the university institution and the rules for its organization and functioning.
- Modernizing and facilitating administrative procedures and bringing the administration closer to the citizen.
- developing the two current platforms (the platform related to the documentation process and the platform related to foreign certificate equivalencies).

- Providing university institutions with more than 130,000 final certificates in all levels for the year 2022, within the framework of the decentralization of the granting of the final graduation certificates.
- Granting autonomy to university institutions for the possibility of printing final certificates on the University Office of Publications starting from the academic year 2022/2023
- Working on preparing practical texts related to the specifications, data and characteristics of university degrees, as well as valuing experience gained.
- The project to create the National Agency of the Quality Assurance and Certification, which is a part of the sector's work plan.

Within the framework of the sector's endeavor represented in the training and research quality, the university institutions governance and their openness to the national and international environment, and under the directives of the President of the Republic, which are the necessity of updating the organizational equipment for reforming education and training.

The sector released a number of texts, for example:

Executive Decree No. 22-208 of June 05th, 2022, related to the studies system and training for obtaining university degrees, which included:

- 1. New forms Institutionalizing of training such as distance education according to the mixed pattern, home training, Alternative and dynamic training.
- 2. Re-sending the engineer and architecture formations.
- 3. The Creation of a National pedagogical committee in addition to the field's pedagogical committee.
- 4. Diversifying enrollment in higher education by adopting the valorization of professional experience gains.
- 5. Establishing a national committee to qualify training offers in all levels.
- 6. Determining the conditions of qualifying, freezing and canceling the training offer.
- 7. Legalizing the training enrollment in the third level through a written competition.
- 8. Unifying the naming of doctorate diploma

The following text refers to 23 applied texts in which the General Directorate of Education and Training has begun preparing.

Establishing of the sector's work program inspired by the government's program, the Directorate of Education, in the first and second levels, also embarked on the following operations:

- Initiating a formation plan review by redistributing branches with national registration to avoid duplication and unattractiveness of formations, to become local or regional formations.
- Working on restoring the gradual balance between the fields of humanities, social sciences and technological sciences.
- Continuing the modifying process of education programs in medical science of the fifth and sixth years.
- Reviewing training programs in the field of Information and

 Communication Sciences and providing for it a special training field.

And for creating **new training points**, it will:

- Merge the Higher School of Mining and Minerals & the Higher School of Industrial Technologies to create a National Higher School of Technology and Engineering in Annaba.
- The National High School of Technology and the High School of Applied Sciences will also be merged to create a National High School for Advanced Technologies to be situated in the Technological Pole of Sidi Abdallah.
- Create two national high schools in desert agriculture in Adrar and El ouadi.

 Also thinking about the creation of a National High School of Nanotechnology.

Last but not least, a draft text has been prepared for the development of the Algerian Open University

University services

The university services sector seeks to develop in several service areas,

- including the financial field through the processes of rationalizing expenditures,
- consultation and discuss with social partners,
- providing security,
- especially digitizing the sector using a unified card used by the student in the service of restaurants and transportation, where an agreement will be made with public institutions to cover transportation through Metro and tram lines, the operation will start in 7 states



The prospects are still open for many operations programmed within the improvement plans, including a training course on the organic law of financial laws and results-based management for the second semester and on internal security in sector institutions.



Financial Affairs

The directorate has already started the realization of an electronic platform of properties, which is a digital platform for properties belonging to the sector, built, movable and functional housing.

In the same context, the sector card for dealers constitutes an important focus in the sector, where the initial vision and future prospects were prepared to be ready at the disposal of the institutions.

Digitization, Network Development and Governance

The Scientific and Technical Media Research Center is working to increase the range of research journals that researchers want to access.

- Transition to IP telephony for all higher education institutions.
- Setting the National System service of Programs via internet to enable students and researchers to be jointed in it, and this allows them to access many programs at the same time and to rationalize expenses, by adding a data center.

- mproving the Internet flow in the field of distance study with a larger capacity and giving the ability to record a large number of video clips to ensure the proper conduct of distance study to avoid falling into crises such as the Corona crisis
- Putting new infrastructures into service, such as cloud technology and HPC, a high-performance account via the data center whose establishment is based on cyber-security.

As forward-looking, the Ministry of Higher Education and Scientific Research, through the Directorate of Digitization and Network Development,

- 1. seeks to create a digital platform for grievances and complaints submitted by members of the university family to reach directly to the concerned directorate.
- 2. digitizing network requests and automated processing of higher education institutions.
- 3. digitizing and counting the Ministry's property and also generalizing the use of Progress platform among students.
- 4. raising the flow of the Internet and work on the development of distance education.

These processes set by the Directorate of Digitization and Network Development into planning and implementation, is aiming at upgrading the sector and facilitating transactions through the transition from paper work to electronic work in conjunction with technological development.



University ethics and morality

As forward-looking of the sector, the Council seeks to consolidate a culture of these ethics through:

- Preparing a questionnaire to know the work of the council and committees in spreading this culture by the help of quality and government bodies
- Reducing the number of complaints that reach the Ministry of treatment at the level of university committees of higher education institutions
- Organizing the International Forum of the Profession University ethics and morality on the next university entry 2022/2023, in which the outcome of the council's work and experiences exchanged will be presented.



the Sector Legislative and Regulatory Activity

To apply the program of the action plan of the sector developing and ensuring the quality of education and scientific research, the Directorate of Legal Affairs is working on issuing a number of texts to determine future prospects, **such as the text that includes the National Agency for Quality Assurance and Accreditation in Higher Education and Research Institutions**

- as well as the establishment of the National Higher School of Advanced Technologies in Sidi Abdallah and the Higher School of Technology and Engineering in Annaba.
- As well as the restructuring of a group of university institutions (University of Saida "Dr. Moulay Taher" and university centers in Mila, Illizi and Naama),
- in addition to prepare the model basic law of the University of Continuous education, which will bear the name of the Algerian Open University as a challenge to the Ministry in the field of higher education and scientific research, as well as technological innovation.
